2 Chronicles 20:6-12

"O Lord, God of our fathers, are you not God in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. In your hand are power and might, so that none is able to withstand you. Did you not, our God, drive out the inhabitants of this land before your people Israel, and give it forever to the descendants of Abraham your friend? And they have lived in it and have built for you in it a sanctuary for your name, saying, 'If disaster comes upon us, the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we will stand before this house and before you-for your name is in this house-and cry out to you in our affliction, and you will hear and save.' And now behold, the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir, whom you would not let Israel invade when they came from the land of Egypt, and whom they avoided and did not destroy—behold, they reward us by coming to drive us out of your possession, which you have given us to inherit. IGHLIGHT KEY PHRASES IN JEHOSHAPHAT'S PRAYER & THEN WRITE YOUR OWN PRAYER

Remind God of who he is: Who do YOU say God is??? Address him as that.	
State what God does: What do you think God does? Mention this in your prayer.	
Remember how powerful God is: Who do you think can defeat God?	
Reflect on the things God has done in your life already: Have you seen him heal? He him restore? Have you seen him move mountains for you? Tell God of these things	



How does God respond to our cries?
Remember whose power you are leaning on – yours or God's?
What will your actions be towards God even when you are filled with fear?
What else do you want to add to your prayer?
