Week 3: "Who are you allied with?"

Extra activities for teachers/small group leaders:

1. Make a list of things you are connected to in your life. Think about whether these are good or bad things and discuss why.
2. Look up Proverbs 12:26 and talk about why it's so important to choose your friends wisely.
3. Were you surprised that God still helped Jehoshaphat even though he made an alliance with an evil King? Why or why not? Write down times you were surprised God could forgive you or someone else.

Challenge: Choose 2 scriptures about friends and memorize them this week. Share with someone else the importance of choosing the right friends.

Memory Verse: Proverbs 13:20 - "Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm."
